

## Terms and Conditions for Hughes Hall Punt Club

Membership of the punt club will last for the period of time for which the member is a student at Hughes Hall.

To join the Hughes Hall Punt Club you must agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. The punt may only be booked out by members of the Hughes Hall Punt Club.
2. The punt may only be booked out for 3 hours at a time.
3. Members who book the Punt are fully responsible for the punt and any damage to it for the period they have booked it for.
4. The members who booked out the punt must remain with it at all times and is responsible for the passengers of the punt.
5. The punt must have no more than six passengers, including the punter, at any time: having more passengers than this invalidates the insurance.
6. Any damage to the punt must be reported to the Admiral of the Punt Club (personal email or [admiral@hughes.cam.ac.uk](mailto:admiral@hughes.cam.ac.uk)) immediately whether it was caused by the user or not.
7. The punt is moored at St John's College. The key can be collected from the porters in the Cripps Building. Any complaints from the St John's porters about behaviour of a Hughes Hull Punt Club member or their guests will lead to that member having their right to use the punt suspended.
8. The Punt and the pole must be securely padlocked to the St John's quay at position Z-2 on return.
9. Users of the punt are to remove all rubbish from the area and deposit it in the bins under the Cripps Building.
10. The Punt may not be taken out of the punt pool after dark: the Porters have instructions not to issue keys to the punt store or the quayside for this purpose after dark. You are reminded that St John's College closes its gates at 10 p.m.
11. The punt may be returned to the punt store after dark; people returning to the punt store after dark are requested to be considerate to those living close by.
12. The punt must be returned to St John's at the end of the period for which it was booked.
13. The punt is owned and operated by Hughes Hall MCR and the college authorities bear no responsibility for it.
14. Anyone found to be misusing the punt will lose the privilege of use and in serious cases the MCR will take disciplinary action
